The Right Honourable Lord Hain of Neath

Lord Hain has very strong ties with South Africa. Educated at Pretoria Boys, Hain and his parents, who were anti-apartheid activists, were forced into exile in 1966. Hain became a leader of the British Anti-Apartheid Movement from 1969 to 1994.

Lord Hain became an MP in 1991 and a member of the House of Lords in 2015. During his political career he gained significant international experience in diplomacy, negotiation and conflict resolution, serving as (among others) British Foreign Office Minister and Europe Minister. As Secretary of State for Northern Ireland from 2005 to 2007, he negotiated the end of the conflict, bringing together old enemies in government in 2007 in an historic political settlement.

In 2005 he received the OR Tambo National Award in Silver for his "Excellent contribution to the freedom struggle".
