

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Embark on a transformative journey with our MBA-HL if you meet the following inclusive entry requirements:

- Academic Excellence: Hold an NQF level 8 qualification or international equivalent, signalling your proven academic ability and commitment to continued learning.
- Industry Experience: Bring at least four years of professional experience in the healthcare sector in either the private or public sector. We highly value the practical insights from your time in the field, particularly if you've spent two years in a managerial or senior position. This experience is key to participating in and contributing to the rich discussions and problem-solving scenarios in the programme.
- Mathematical Proficiency: Demonstrate a level of competence in Maths equivalent to the South African Matriculation Certificate. This proficiency ensures your readiness for the quantitative elements of the programme.
- Language Skills: Display proficiency in English, the language of instruction for the programme. Clear and effective communication is vital for active participation and success in our global learning environment.
- Admission Test Scores: Achieve an acceptable score in either the GMAT, NMAT or the WBS admission test. These scores help us assess your potential for academic success in the MBA-HL programme.

JOIN US IF:

- You have an NQF level 8 qualification.
- You have a minimum of four years' work experience in the healthcare sector (two years in a managerial or senior position).
- You have a level of competence in mathematics equivalent to the South African matriculation certificate.
- You are proficient in English.
- You have completed and achieved an acceptable level/ score in either the GMAT, NMAT or the WBS admission test.
- You have a SAQA Evaluation Certificate (applicable to international qualifications)
- International Qualifications: If you obtained your qualifications outside South Africa, you will need to present
 a SAQA Evaluation Certificate. This requirement ensures the comparability of international qualifications with
 the South African National Qualifications Framework.

Our entry requirements are designed to ensure that all our MBA-HL students bring a diverse set of skills and experiences to the programme, enriching the learning experience for everyone. If you meet these requirements and are committed to advancing your leadership skills in the healthcare sector, we welcome your application. CLASS STUDY FORMATS

The WBS MBA-HL is offered on a part-time (2 years) basis comprising both face-to-face and online classes.

Our MBA-HL at WBS embraces a forward-thinking, flexible and dynamic study format designed to meet your unique needs and foster an immersive learning experience. We utilize a blend of learning methods: face-to-face on-campus; real-time online classes; and peer-to-peer engagement.

The study format caters to various learning styles and logistical considerations, ensuring everyone can fully engage and contribute. The course design is engineered for seamless transitions between in-person and online settings, with a view to accommodating the needs of healthcare professionals.

The classes will be divided into 7 blocks commencing in March 2024 and ending in December 2025. Students will be required to attend face-to-face classes during the first and last weekend of each block (Friday evening, Saturday, and Sunday). Further, during each block, students will attend online lectures (2 hours per week), engage in online peer-to-peer activities and individual tasks. The assessments would be either online or in person undertaken at the end of each block.

Through this innovative approach, our MBA-HL programme offers an enriching, comprehensive, and accessible learning journey that equips healthcare leaders to thrive amidst the challenges of the ever-evolving global healthcare landscape.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

INDEPENDENT STUDY PORTION

1. Leadership Quest

The 'Leadership Quest' is an ongoing, independent study component in which students identify through research and literature, the characteristics of an effective leader. Emphasis is on personal development, self-awareness and individual coaching.

2. Applied research project

Students undertake an individual research project on a topic related to healthcare issues, developments or leadership.

GLOBAL STUDY TOUR

As an integral component of the MBA-HL programme,

students will engage in an international study tour designed to provide them with insights into global healthcare leadership practices and developments.

ELECTIVE COURSES

Students can choose courses from the following electives (not all will be offered in every academic year).

- Required documents at application stage are on the Checklist.
 - Shortlisted applicants may sit for one of the three admission tests: GMAT, NMAT or WBS admission test. The shortlisted candidate will receive confirmation from the school to write the WBS admission test.
 - Shortlisted RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning) applicants will be required to take only GMAT test. More information can be found on www.gmat.com.
 - Applicants will be required to attend an interview.
 - A minimum deposit will be required upon acceptance of a place on the programme
